The objective of the assignment is to assess the market potential for Technical Vocational Education & Training (TVET) programs in Iraq, through: i) assessing potential demand-supply gap for market relevant Technical Vocational Educati- on & Training (TVET) programs in priority sectors in Iraq, and ii) identify TVET supply opportunities based on the identified demand-supply gaps, with a focus on vulnerable communities in Iraq.

The assessment shall identify priority market sectors for the country while considering with IFC and the Partners priority sectors in Iraq, which are: natural gas, electricity, agribusiness, construction, financial sector, aviation, health, ports and logistics.
