To generate an assessment of the emergency preparedness and response (EP&R) capacity in Somalia to face all kinds of disasters, including health emergencies, flood, droughts, food shortages , and incidents of mass casualty violence. To propose consensus priority EP&R investments (based on the preferred model) at the FGS and FMS levels and for-mulate an Investment Plan.

To support the operationalization of the National Emergency Operations Centre within the EP&R system by reaching consensus about (i) refining its mandate; (ii) proposing an approach to consolidate of its legal framework; (iii) detailed institutional design; (iv) coordination and collaboration between the NEOC, state, sectoral and non-state EP&R (v) identifying the infrastructure and financial requirements for it operationalization; and To develop the Somalia Food Security Preparedness Plan (FSPP) .
