1. Background

The Government of Somaliland has received Additional Financing from the World Bank towards the implementation of the Domestic Revenue Mobilization (DRM) and Public Financial Management (PFM) Capacity Strengthening Project. The overall project development objective (PDO) is to 'strengthen systems of domestic revenue mobilization, expenditure control and accountability in Somaliland.

The GoSL therefore wishes to use part of the funds allocated under the Domestic Revenue Mobilization (DRM) and Public Financial Management (PFM) Capacity Strengthening Project to pay for the services requested in the Terms of Reference.

2. Scope of Work and Responsibilities

The IPSAS Technical Adviser will be responsible for the following: i) Exercise a detailed diagnosis and identify gaps for IPSAS adoption. ii) Analyze all relevant aspects – capacity, policies, procedures, regulatory, information system/ software etc. including review of existing chart of accounts and alignment with IPSAS adoption. iii) Assist Accountant General Office in preparing IPSAS based annual financial statements for with required opening balances/ conversions. iv) Enable Accountant General Office to prepare full IPSAS compliant financial reports; vi) Build the capacity of AGO staff with required knowledge of IPSAS Standards in the implementation process. He/she will perform other tasks described in the ToR.

3. Selection Criteria

Selection shall be based on qualification and experience of the candidate and followed by an interview. The minimum qualification, experience and skills should include:

Knowledge

1. The technical assistant (TA) must be chartered accountant, CPA, ACCA or equivalent and at least Master's Degree in Public Finance Studies or equivalent with accounting subjects
2. The TA must have IPSAS professional qualification from chartered institutes like ACCA, CIPFA or similar recognized bodies

Experience

1. The TA must have at least (10) years' experience in the field of public accounting in which at least 5 years in the fragile government's public sector accounting and financial reporting.
2. Specific experience: The consultant must have considerable experience in the field of International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS) and some years' experience about the Integrated Financial Management Information System (IFMIS)



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3. Special Requirement as advantage: Consultant having experience with similar assignments (IPSAS conversion) shall have added advantage.

4. Duration of the Assignment

The duration for the assignment is 12 months, renewable based on satisfactory performance.

5. The Ministry of Finance now invites eligible Individual Consultants to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested Individual Consultants must submit their Curriculum Vitae (CV) and cover letter indicating that they are qualified to perform the services.
