ASSIGNMENT DESCRIPTION

The World Bank's Tunisia health team seeks to hire a firm to support Tunisia in developing the country's vaccine production strategy. Support will be provided to the World Bank health team and the Government of Tunisia national vaccine production taskforce in the following areas: (i) a benchmarking exercise on recent international experiences on vaccine production across different dimensions, as well as international actors who can provide technology transfer to Tunisia; (ii) a feasibility study on the implementation of an mRNA production platform, as well as other vaccine production modalities, in Tunisia; and (iii) the development of inputs for an action plan for vaccine production in Tunisia on the basis of the benchmarking exercise and feasibility study.

Task 1: International benchmarking on vaccine production: This task includes the following activities:

Task 2: Landscaping of existing capabilities along the vaccine development and production chain in Tunisia to assess the feasibility

- 2. MENA and Maghreb experience on technical assistance and/or research on vaccine and pharmaceutical monitoring, including relationships with biomedical and pharmaceutical companies 20 percent



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- 3. Adequacy of methodology and the proposed work plan in responding to the Terms of Reference. 30 percent
- 4. Qualifications and competence of the key staff related to the assignment. 30 percent
