ASSIGNMENT DESCRIPTION

The World Banks Tunisia health team seeks to hire a firm to support Tunisia in developing the countrys vaccine pro- duction strategy. Support will be provided to the World Bank health team and the Government of Tunisia national vaccine production taskforce in the following areas: (i) a benchmarking exercise on recent international experiences on vaccine production across different dimensions, as well as international actors who can provide technology transfer to Tunisia; (ii) a feasibility study on the implementation of an mRNA production platform, as well as other vaccine pro- duction modalities, in Tunisia; and (iii) the development of inputs for an action plan for vaccine production in Tunisia on the basis of the benchmarking exercise and feasibility study.

Qualification Criteria

- 1. Firm should have a team of consultants who are well-experienced in the Tunisia health sector/pharmaceutical production context, with both public and private sector stakeholders.
- 2. Firm should have international experience on technical assistance and/or research related to vaccine and pharmaceutical manufacturing, including on mRNA technology, and relationships established with biomedical and pharmaceutical companies regarding vaccine production methods including mRNA (especially in the MENA region).



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- 3. Firm should have experience on project management and implementation pertaining to this task.
- 4. Firm should have a regional presence and the ability to provide on-the-ground data collection in Tunisia as needed, as well as experience working directly with government clients in Tunisia and Maghreb region.
- 5. Consultants should be fluent in English and French at a minimum; Arabic would be an asset.
